# **PRESIDENTS MESSAGE**

Hi All: I thought the message I had John send out recently was worth repeating.

Thursday Evening

The bridge club is starting a new open game starting at 7:00 on Thursday evenings. The existing under 300 game will continue to run at 7:15. The tables in the under 300 game will be credited to the open game as well so there will be increased master points available. We are doing this for several reasons. First there is no other open game for club players who do not go to face-to-face games, other than the open game Individual + Robot on Tuesdays at 12:45 pm. Secondly the size of the face-to-face games at the club has been dwindling. Last week for example we had 41.5 tables in total between online and club play. To reach a break even position we need approximate 55-60 tables per week. The Thursday evening open is therefore two-fold. Offer a play time to players with over 1000 Mps. Secondly to increase revenues. Several people have asked me what they can do to support the club. Here is the answer. If we could get about 14 tables in the open category this one night a week, we might be able to get back in the black. The simplest thing to do to support the club is to play in this one game a week. Even the snow-birds can support us by playing in this one game.

We really do need the support of our club members if we are to remain a viable organization. I understand that it is very hard to maintain club membership and attachment in these times of social distancing and COVID restrictions, but if we pull together, we can prevail and emerge from this time, with a strong club.

Times have changed and the executive have noticed that tables on Mondays have dropped to as few as 4. It is thought that including lunch is probably a deterrent whereas it used to be a feature. Therefore, as of Monday February 7th the Monday game will now start at 1 pm and run the same as all afternoon games.

Regina is now going to run on-line games on Sundays, we ask you to support those games as well as the net revenue is returned proportionally the same as we do.

In a recent mail out from our President, Jerry talked about the need to get to about 55-60 tables a week to break even. To put that into perspective, we were averaging 96 tables a week prior to the Pandemic.

For the first 6 months of this year while we were closed we averaged around 45 tables a week on-line. During this time we broke even.

Since we have been open the combined online and F2F the second half of the year we have gone down 39 tables and run a deficit. So I agree with Jerry that we need to get to the 55-60 tables a week combined to be successful again. We can do it. The month of September we averaged 60 tables a week. (Silver week 62.5 tables) John


